As concerns mount over the ramifications of coronavirus on the healthcare industry, we would like to assure our customers that Geri-Care Pharmaceuticals takes its role of supplying vital medicines to the healthcare industry very seriously. Especially during these times of great need.

To that end, we are taking precautions to ensure that our manufacturing operations follow the strictest safety standards as we continue to produce our wide range of high-quality and safe products for our customers. These precautions include the following:

1. We are closely adhering to CDC guidelines regarding cleanliness and sanitizing. As a pharmaceutical facility, our employees on the manufacturing lines wear mandatory gowns and hair nets. To further enhance our standards, we have added protective gloves and masks to our supervising personnel.
2. We have divided our workforce into multiple shifts so that if someone contracts the virus, we can continue operating with employees who have not been in contact with the infected employee.
3. Within shifts, we are mandating a zero-contact policy between work rooms to minimize contact between employees as much as possible.
4. The lunchroom and bathroom facilities are being allocated to specific shifts.
5. All non-essential employees are encouraged to work from home.
6. In addition to the standard cGMP wash down, all facilities are now sanitized with antibacterial spray between shifts.
7. With the advent of school closings, we have implemented additional shifts, at our cost, to accommodate parental childcare.
8. We have temporarily discontinued use of the hand stamp punch clock.

We are fully aware of how important it is that there be no interruptions in the supply of healthcare products. As such, we have taken every precaution to ensure that our employees stay safe, and that our facilities maintain the strictest sanitary conditions so that we may continue all operations necessary to ensure timely delivery of our products to our customers.
