Docusate Sodium 100 mg......Stool Softener Laxative

- Uses relieves occasional constinuation (irregularity)
  - generally produces bowel movement in 12 to 72 hours

## Warnings

## Ask a doctor before use if you

- have stomach pain, nausea or vomiting
- have a sudden change in bowel habits that persists over a period of 2 weeks
- · are presently taking mineral oil

### Stop use and ask a doctor if

- you need to use a laxative longer than 1 week
- you have rectal bleeding or fail to have a bowel movement. These could be signs of a serious condition.

If pregnant or breast-feeding, ask a health professional before use.

Keep out of the reach of children. In case of overdose, get medical help or contact a Poison Control Center right away.
