Do not use if you are allergic to aspirin or any other pain reliever/fever reducer.

Ask a doctor before use if • the stomach bleeding warning applies to you • you are taking a diuretic • you have a history of stomach problems, such as heartburn • you have: ° high blood pressure ° heart disease ° liver cirrhosis ° kidiney disease ° asthma

Ask a doctor or pharmacist before use if you are • taking a prescription drug for diabetes, gout or arthritis

Stop use and ask a doctor if • you experience any of the following signs of stomach bleeding: - feel faint • vomit blood • have bloody or black stools • have stomach pain that does not get better • an allergic reaction occurs. Seek medical help right away. • pain gets worse or lasts more than 10 days • redness or swelling is present • fever gets worse or lasts more than 3 days • any new symptoms occur • ringing in the ears or loss of hearing occurs.
